

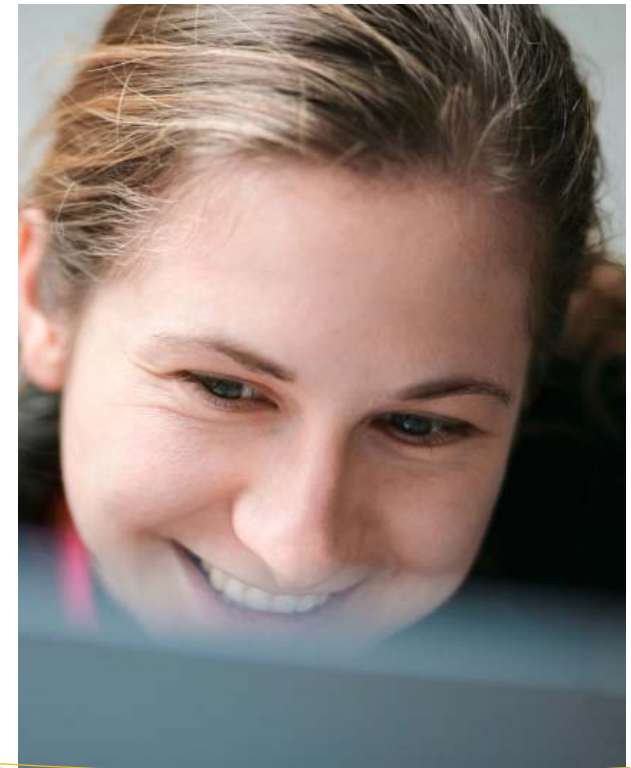

Description of Classes

Basic Computer Skills (Windows 7) – This beginner class covers how to start using Windows 7 and tools to keep your computer happy.

Ohio Web Library – Learn how to get the information you need from the Internet by using the OPLIN Databases. You'll be amazed at the information that's available at your fingertips.
