

BEHAVIOR GUIDELINES

London Public Library is open to all individuals without regard to age, race, religion, national origin, mental or physical disability, social or political views. The library is dedicated to providing an atmosphere conducive to study, reading and the legitimate use of library materials and services.

In order to foster this environment, it is necessary that each person act in a manner which is respectful of library functions and considerate of other patrons and library staff. Any behavior or conditions which disrupts the orderly use of the library, normal library operations, or affects the staff's ability to provide service to the public is prohibited. Patrons whose behavior is disruptive or in violation of library policy may be asked to leave the building.

The following behavior is not permitted because it interferes with the use of the library by others, is a health or safety hazard or because it is not consistent with the mission of the library:

- Sleeping, playing games and/or other activities which interfere with the use of the library.
- Using the library without shirt or shoes.
- Wearing swimsuits in the building.
- Eating or drinking in designated areas of the library.
- Smoking in the building or in entryways to the building.
- Playing audio equipment so others can hear it.
- Bathing or any other inappropriate use of the public restrooms.
- Using rollerblades, roller skates, skateboard, or other sports equipment in the library or on library property.
- Blocking aisles so access to library materials and services is prevented.
- Loitering
- Entering unauthorized workspaces or office areas.
- Interfering with another's legitimate use and enjoyment of the library and its materials.
- Actions, including public displays of affection, which are disruptive or distracting to others.
- Solicitation of library personnel or patrons on the library grounds.

When necessary the library will work with law enforcement authorities to prosecute actions for criminal behavior against the library, its patrons and staff, including but not limited to:

- Loud, abusive, aggressive, threatening, harassing, or obscene language and/or behavior (disorderly conduct).
- Defacing or damaging library materials, furniture or other property.
- Using or distributing illegal drugs.
- Circumventing or attempting to circumvent the library security system.
- Tampering with, altering, editing or damaging computer hardware and/or software.
- Causing panic.

In the event of an emergency, patrons shall comply with instructions from library personnel.

Animals are not permitted in the library except for those assisting disabled persons and those involved in library-related programs.

Valuables and personal belongings should not be left unattended. The library is not responsible for damaged, lost, or stolen articles.

All cellular phones and audible pagers will be used only on the lower level of the library.
